Installation

- Secure the trap to a flat, sturdy surface through the holes in the base plate.

Use

- Always assure safety cover is on and securely fastened prior to use.
- Place muzzle of firearm 2-3" into the shooting tube. When clearing a shotgun or a rifle with a muzzle brake, make sure the muzzle of the firearms are past the inside end of the shooting tube (approximately 8").

- Discard all bullets and bullet material in proper containers, as required by law and local ordinances.
- Only use manufacturer's recommended products with units.

Warnings

- Close proximity shooting is by nature dangerous and we recommend the user wear proper Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) when using or maintaining the Snail Trap.
- Certain types of bullets may result in fragments being emitted from the trap.
- Wash hands after each use or maintenance procedure.

Removing Spent Bullets

Freestanding: The Freestanding Check-It is designed to leave the spent bullet material in the bottom of the trap. It is recommended that you remove the spent bullets after each discharge to prevent a build-up of material in the bottom of the deceleration chamber that could pose a safety hazard to other users. To remove spent bullet material, unbolt the unit and carefully tip it on its side. Carefully turn the trap on its top and tip it back towards the vent. Collect and discard the bullet material into the proper container for recycling/disposal.

Tabletop and Mini: The Tabletop and Mini units are designed to have the spent bullet material drop out of the bottom of the trap. To remove spent bullet material, unbolt the trap and carefully tip it on its side. Collect the bullet material and discard into a proper container for recycling/disposal.

All models: After removing the spent bullet material, remove the safety cover and, using a flashlight, inspect the ramps for scarring, bulging, cracks or damage. If damage is noted, remove the unit from use and call Savage Range Systems for instruction.
